SHOWING vs TELLING Adding more descriptive verbs is a great way to spice up your writing. Adjectives and adverbs make a difference, too.

My friend and I laughed.
My friend and I doubled over with laughter.
The student gave a presentation.
The student stumbled through his presentation.
The student stuttered and wiped his brow as he stumbled through his presentation.
I saw a low-flying plane in the sky.
My mouth hung open at the sight of the low-flying plane.
I did a good job at my dance performance.
I spun and flew across the stage gracefully during my dance performance.
The lion ate his food.
The sun-glittered lion devoured the hyena.
